

CLUB RULES

1. All persons riding at the CWRA arena must be financial members of the CWRA unless invited as guests.
2. Safe riding attire must be worn at all times. I.e. riding boots - no joggers or trainers with deep tread.
3. No horse is to be ridden either in a halter only or bareback.
4. Acceptable equipment Western bridles, snaffle bridles, . Bosal and appropriate saddles. Equipment will be checked.
5. Stallions must be ridden by a 19 year old or over - no youth.
6. Stallions, when not being ridden must either be;
 - double tied
 - tied and hobbled
 - confined to a yard
 - or kept in stalls
7. Stallions tied at the float must have a barrier around them
8. No horse is to be left tied in the arena or to the arena fence.
9. Owners of horses that are known to kick should courteously warn people or place a red ribbon in the horses tail.
10. Owners of any horse behaving in a dangerous manner, putting others at risk, may be approached by a committee member and asked to remove the animal from the situation immediately.
11. Horses must only be ridden in designated areas.
12. No junior members are to be left in the arena unsupervised.
13. Gates must be kept closed.
14. Any damage to the arena must be reported to the committee immediately.
15. Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times.
16. Youth to wear helmet

ANY BREACH OF THE RULES AND CODES OF THE CWRA MAY LEAD TO DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS AND/OR REVIEW OF MEMBERSHIP.

CODE OF CONDUCT

***It is expected that all members of the CWRA will conduct themselves in a courteous and responsible manner both inside and outside the arena, otherwise you will be asked to leave and membership may be revoked.**

***No person is to attend a club a day under the influence of alcohol or drugs.**

***Riders are required to notify the committee of any existing medical conditions, e.g. epilepsy. This information will be kept confidential.**
